

Dear Parents:

This year in Sunday morning Bible study your child will be gaining an overall understanding of the Bible and its key themes as he/she learns who God is and what He has done, as presented in His Word. Using the curriculum "Firm Foundations Creation to Christ", the 3rd graders will be taught the Bible chronologically and discover how God has revealed Himself from the beginning until now. The Old Testament lessons lay the foundation for why Jesus is our only hope, and in the Gospels we discover that Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promises from the Old Testament. These lessons lay a good foundation for a clear, God-centered presentation of the Gospel. We want children to not just know parts of the Bible, but to have an overall, comprehensive, chronological understanding of the Bible.

In order to do this we must read and memorize the Bible. We know who God is, His character, and what He has done because He has revealed Himself and His mighty works to us in the Bible.
