Saturday Service Day Opportunities:

Miracle Hill Ministries:

1. Rescue Mission – Wash buses and vans. (About 5–10 people.)
2. Overcomers Center (The Monastery) – Clean debris in yard, trim trees and shrubs, spray roundup and clean around outside of building. (As much as 25-30 people.)
3. Relief Ministry – May have project depending on what donations have come in the week before. Often we have produce or other items that need to be sorted. (About 5-10 people.)

Child Evangelism Fellowship:

1. Build cabinet to enclose our office network computer which is located in our basement. (need supplies)
2. Build a crawl space door under in the basement where bricks have been busted out. (need supplies)
3. Need an exterior window to be sanded, primed and painted. We have the paint. (Need scraper, sandpaper, caulk & brush)
4. Need a small bathroom subfloor repaired and new linoleum (about 4x5') installed. Commode needs to be offset so it will fit properly against the wall. (Need to have commode removed and drain moved, then patch subfloor and install linoleum, a remnant 4x5' will work)
5. We could use help from youth or children to make and assemble some materials we will need for the CYIA summer missionaries to use as they teach in 5 day clubs. (2-8 people who will work at the CEF office)
6. Clean and Paint concrete basement floor. We do not have paint (measures about 12-24')
7. Prayerwalk some of these schools that do not have Good News Clubs.
