P.—Praise. Sunday evening, February 28, we will come together in a time of prayer to give God praise. It will be a time to tell God that we adore Him and thank Him for who He is and all He has done for His children. Psalm 69:30 says, “I will praise God’s name in song and glorify Him with thanksgiving.”

R.—Repent. Monday evening, March 1, we will come together in a time of prayer of confession and repentance. It will be a time to come before our Lord and ask the Holy Spirit to reveal to us our inadequacies and weaknesses. Acts 3:19-20 says, “Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.”

A.—Ask. Tuesday evening, March 2, we will come together in a time of prayer and supplication. Supplication is asking God for something. Two types of supplication are intercession (praying for others) and petition (praying for your own needs). I John 5:14 says, “This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.”

Y.—Yield. Wednesday evening, March 3, we will come together in a time of prayer to pause and listen to God’s Word. This will be a time to hear the Spirit speak to us about ways the Father will accomplish His will through His people. It will be a time to discover your purpose for living! Psalm 130:5 says, “I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in His word I put my hope.”
