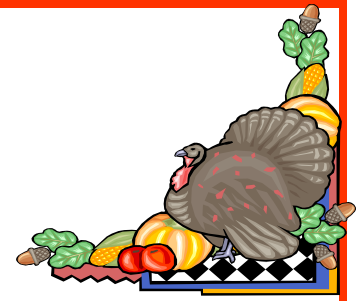
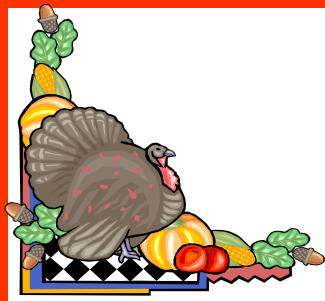

If symptoms start, call your physician. Antiviral drugs, Tamiflu, and Relenza seem to work when taken shortly after symptoms begin.
